

Please respect our neighbors by keeping noise levels to a minimum, especially between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.


#### O4

#### Kitchen

 All appliances, utensils, and dish ware are provided for your convenience. If any of these items are missing at the end of your stay, you will be charged for their replacement.

#### Bathroom

• Please do not flush anything other than toilet paper. This house runs on septic tank. Do not flush or dispose of the following items in the toilets or sinks: sanitary products (tampons, pads), paper towels, condoms, food or any solid objects.

#### Electronics

• The chalet offers high-speed wireless internet and a smart TV, providing access to streaming services like Netflix and Disney Plus for your entertainment (using your personal account). Please note that traditional cable TV channels are not available.




#### Spa

- The hot tub is always on and has a capacity of 4 people. You can turn on the water jets, which will automatically turn off after a certain period.
- When you have finished using the spa, do not turn it off.
- Shower before and after using the spa.
- Do not bring food, drinks or glass containers into the spa.
- No smoking/vaping while using the spa.
- The maximum water temperature should not exceed 104°F/40°C.
- Keep your spa sessions to 20 minutes or less to prevent overheating or dehydration.
- Children should never use the spa without adult supervision.
- Always replace and secure the cover when the spa is not in use. Do not sit or lie on the spa cover.
- Dry yourself with the spa towels before entering the chalet.
- To maintain a respectful environment for all our guests, do not release any bodily fluids in the spa (such as urine, blood, saliva, sperm, etc.).

Please note that excessive or inappropriate use of the spa may result in a \$250 plus tax fee for draining and thorough cleaning of the water.


#### Parking

• There are four parking spots available for a maximum of four cars. During your stay, you must park your vehicle in the spot designated for your unit. Any vehicle parked illegally will be towed at your expense.

#### Outdoor Fire pit

- Maintain a safe distance from the fire pit while it is in use. Keep children and pets at least 3 meters away.
- Never leave the fire pit unattended.
- Use only approved fuels like firewood.
   Do not burn garbage, plastics, or treated wood.
- Keep flammable materials like paper, dry leaves, and chemicals away from the fire pit.
- Always have a fire extinguisher, sand, or a bucket of water nearby in case of emergency.
- Use the fire pit cover to prevent embers from flying out.
- Never use gasoline or other accelerants to start or maintain the fire.
- Avoid overloading the fire pit with too much wood to prevent uncontrolled fires.
- Fully extinguish the fire before leaving the area or going to bed.

#### Insects and wildlife


• Since your stay is in a forested area, encountering insects or wildlife is a possibility. We regularly inspect and maintain our units to minimize this, but we cannot guarantee that you won't see some during your visit. It's important to keep doors and windows closed to prevent these unwanted visitors from entering the chalet. Additionally, avoid leaving food out or garbage uncovered, as these can attract wildlife. If you do encounter a significant issue, please contact us immediately so we can address it. Keep that mind these occasional encounters are part of the natural setting, and we appreciate your understanding and cooperation in keeping the chalet secure.

#### Rules for Using the Lake

- For safety reasons, swimming in the lake and the use of motorized boats are not permitted. Use the lake only for paddle boarding and kayaking.
- Your safety is our priority. Always wear a lifejacket when using the paddle boards or kayaks, and ensure they are properly fastened. Before using any equipment, inspect it for damage or wear. If you notice any issues, report them to the host immediately.
- All children must wear lifejackets when near or on the water. Ensure the lifejacket fits properly and is securely fastened. Children and all nonswimmers must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times when near the lake or using any equipment. Never leave children unattended.
- We provide two paddle boards and two kayaks for your use. Please handle them with care. Ensure that the paddle boards and kayaks are not overloaded and are used according to their intended purpose.
- After using the paddle boards and kayaks, please clean them with the water pipe located next to the spa and return them to their designated storage area. This helps maintain the equipment's condition and ensures it's ready for the next user.
- Use the lake only from sunrise to sunset. Nighttime lake activities are not allowed. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.



#### Please note...

The fire extinguisher, the first aid kit and the boat essential kit are behind the sink, in the kitchen. Bring the boat essential kit with you when going on the lake. It includes a 15m heaving line with a float, a sound signalling device, a watertight flashlight with batteries. The items are housed in a watertight container that can also serve as a bailing device. It's your responsibility to ensure all items are in good condition and ready for use before you head to the lake. Afterward, please place them back in their container and return them to the kitchen so they're ready for our next guest to use. If any item is missing or broken, please let us know.

#### Rules for Using the Lake

- The lake and its surrounding environment are to be respected. Avoid disturbing wildlife, damaging plants, or littering. Keep noise levels to a minimum, especially in the early morning and evening.
- You are responsible for any damage to the paddle boards, kayaks, or other equipment during your use. If an item is broken, damaged or lost you may be charged for repair or replacement costs.
- In case of emergency, ensure you have a means of communication to call for help. Know the location of safety equipment, and inform others of your plans when heading out onto the lake.
- Limited Liability: While we strive to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment, the host is not responsible for any accidents, injuries, or loss of personal belongings that occur while using the lake or its equipment. By using the lake, you agree to these terms and acknowledge that you do so at your own risk.


### BEFORE YOU GO

- Close all the windows and lock the patio door.
- Fill up and start the dishwasher.
- Lower the heating to 17 degrees Celsius in all of the rooms.
- Ensure that the spa cover is put back in place.
- Ensure that the outdoor fire pit is extinguished and that debris/trash is cleaned up.
- Clean the BBQ
- Dispose of any remaining trash and recycling in the appropriate bins on Louis-Pépin street.
- Double-check to ensure that you have gathered all of your personal belongings before leaving. The host cannot be held responsible for items left behind.

## CHECK OUT

#### CHECK IN TIME 4:00 PM

On the day of your arrival, you'll receive instructions, including the digital code for entry. Arrival is at 4:00 PM or later. Your chalet will not be cleaned or available before then. The coded lock associated with your reservation will not be valid until 4:00 PM on the scheduled day of your arrival.

#### CHECK OUT TIME 11:00 AM

Check-out time is at 11:00 AM. We regret that we are unable to accommodate late check-outs. Arrival and departure times are strictly enforced to ensure that the cabin is prepared for our next guests. Any departure after the specified time will incur a fee of \$100 per guest remaining without prior authorization.



To reserve the cabin, a 25% deposit is required at the time of booking if your stay is more than 30 days away. Regardless of when you book, full payment by credit card is due 30 days before your stay to confirm your reservation.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

A full refund is available for cancellations made within 48 hours of booking if the arrival date is at least 30 days away. No refunds will be granted for cancellations made within 30 days of the arrival date. Additionally, no discounts or refunds will be offered for early departures.

#### SAFETY DEPOSIT

A \$750 security deposit per chalet is required 5 days before your arrival. The deposit must be submitted via a credit card or Interac e-transfer to **rent.hubble@outlook.com**, which the renter agrees to do 5 days before the stay begins. The deposit will be refunded within 2 business days after departure, provided that all terms of the rental agreement have been followed.

If there's any violation or damage, the deposit will be retained while we process the case. Any missing or broken items will be charged to the renter.

The renter agrees that the property owner may use the security deposit to cover any expenses or penalties incurred during the stay. If the costs and penalties exceed the amount of the security deposit, the renter agrees to have the additional charges billed to their credit card.

In case of a no-show within 24 hours after the scheduled arrival date without the host's knowledge, the accommodation will be rebooked, and no refund will be issued to the client. We reserve the right to change the rules and policies as needed.

## Useful informations

#### Maximum Guest Limit Policy

The maximum number of guests permitted in our rental cabin is five. This limit applies to both adults and children and is strictly enforced to ensure the comfort and safety of all guests. If you need accommodation for a fifth guest, there is an extra fee of \$75 per night. Exceeding the guest limit without prior authorization may result in eviction without a refund and an additional fee of \$500 will be charged.

#### Moise

Please keep noise levels to a minimum at all times, especially during the evening and early morning hours. Respect the quiet atmosphere of our rental cabin and be considerate of neighbors and other guests. Loud music, shouting, or any disruptive noise is not permitted. Quiet hours are in effect from 10 pm to 7 am.

If the Host or their representative discovers or receives noise complaints and has to visit the property to warn the Renter, a fee of \$250 (plus taxes) will be applied for each visit. Therefore, it's highly recommended that the Renter be reachable by phone at all times.

After two phone calls or a visit to the property by the Host or their representative, the Renter may be evicted without a refund, and a \$500 penalty will be deducted from the security deposit to compensate inconvenienced neighbors.

If the host receives a noise complaint from the police, the Renter will be automatically evicted without a refund, and a \$500 penalty will be deducted from the security deposit as compensation for the disturbed neighbors.

Avoid using water to conserve the water tank supply. If the power does not return within a reasonable time, contact us for further instructions and assistance.

Guests are responsible for any damages they cause to the property during their stay. The Host reserves the right to charge guests for repairs or additional cleaning if needed. By booking with us, you agree to indemnify the Host for any damages, lawsuits, or losses arising from your actions or negligence.


